That is a difficult one to answer, let me explain.


I was trading LO, as explained in my previous [post 5026](#) and then started with TO (actually GMT 00:10).

Because I am retired I don't have any "work" commitments as such, unlike many others here on FF ... this is basically a hobby/challenge and I'm doing it to financially set-up some family members and friends plus to continue my long term commitments to those less fortunate on [Kiva](#) etc.

Now, normally if I meet my daily target of 1-2% with 00:10 then I will either stop (bird in the hand is worth two in the bush ... I was told it was an old Aussie saying, but not sure) or I will also trade London now (07:10).

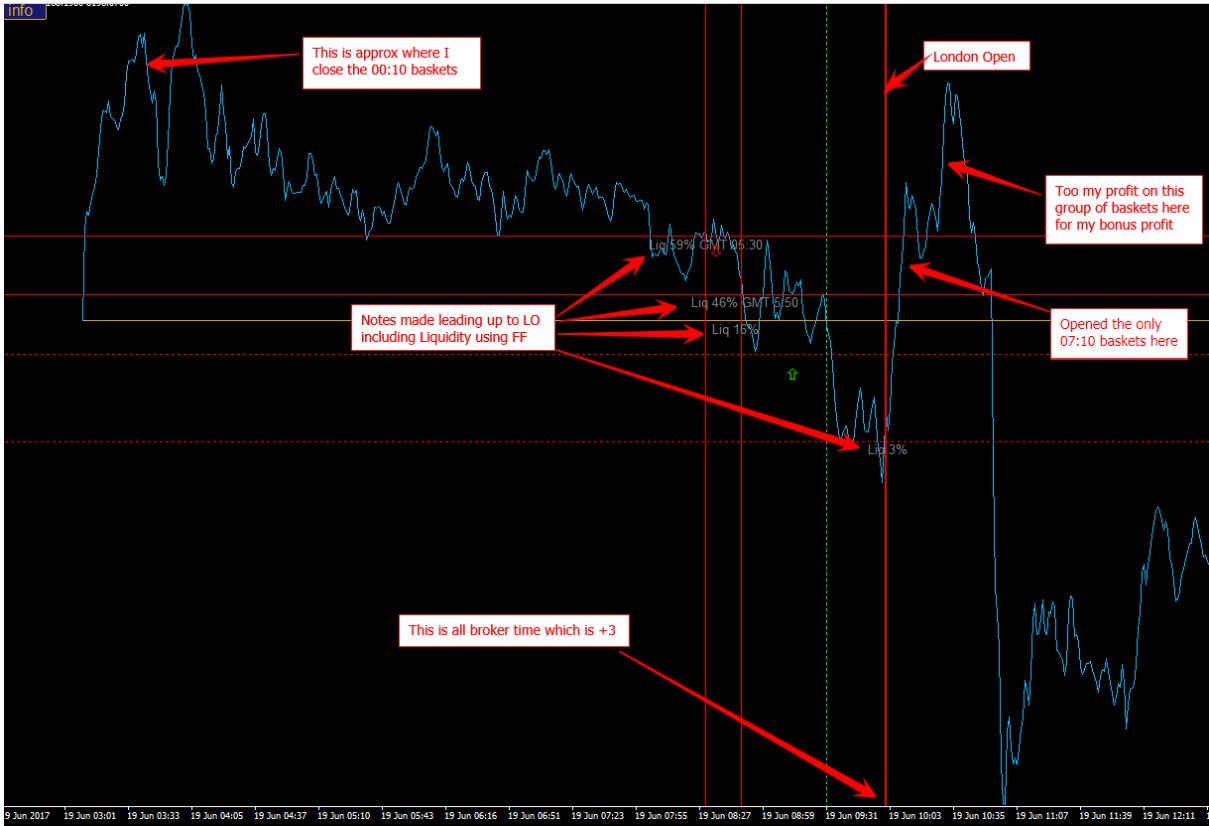
Today is a good example, as I said I operate several live accounts and they all did well at 00:10 - the largest one I shared here, the others all got just over 4% each.

Because I also run a demo account in parallel I leave that running to see what is happening nearer LO (07:10) and I today decided that I would do just 1 group of baskets at 07:10 and that added another 1.6% profit
