Yes Australia will get the effects so will US and other countries which depend on Chinese cheap labor and manufacturing plants that are there seating idle.



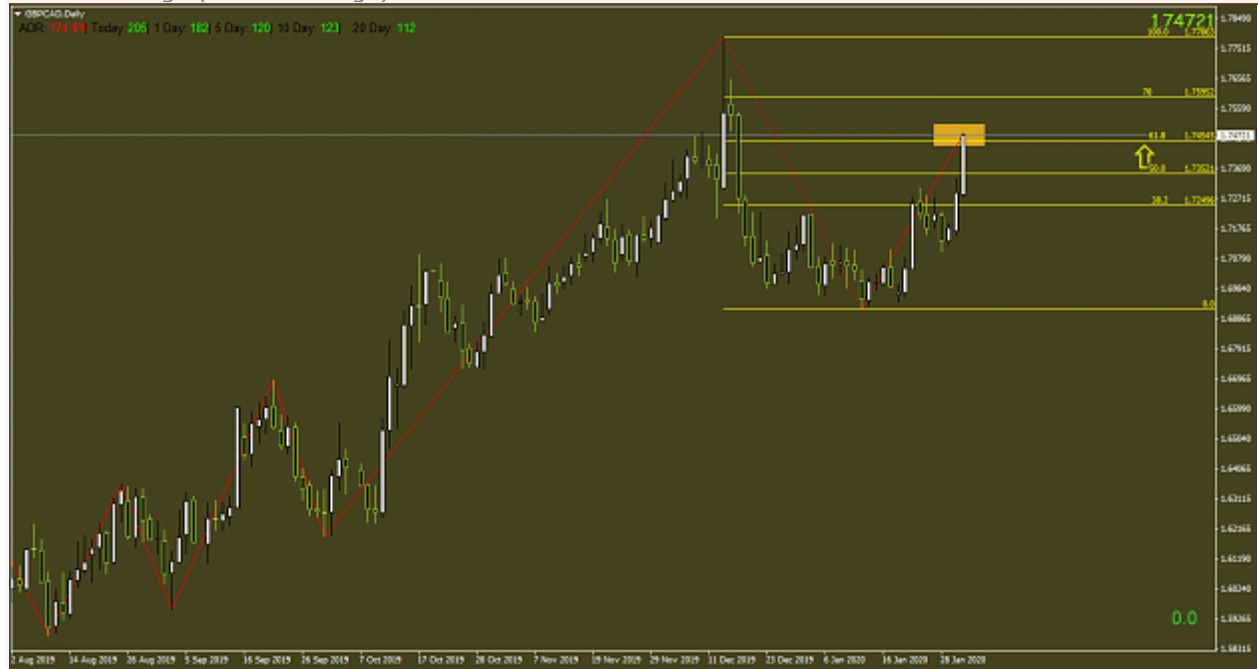

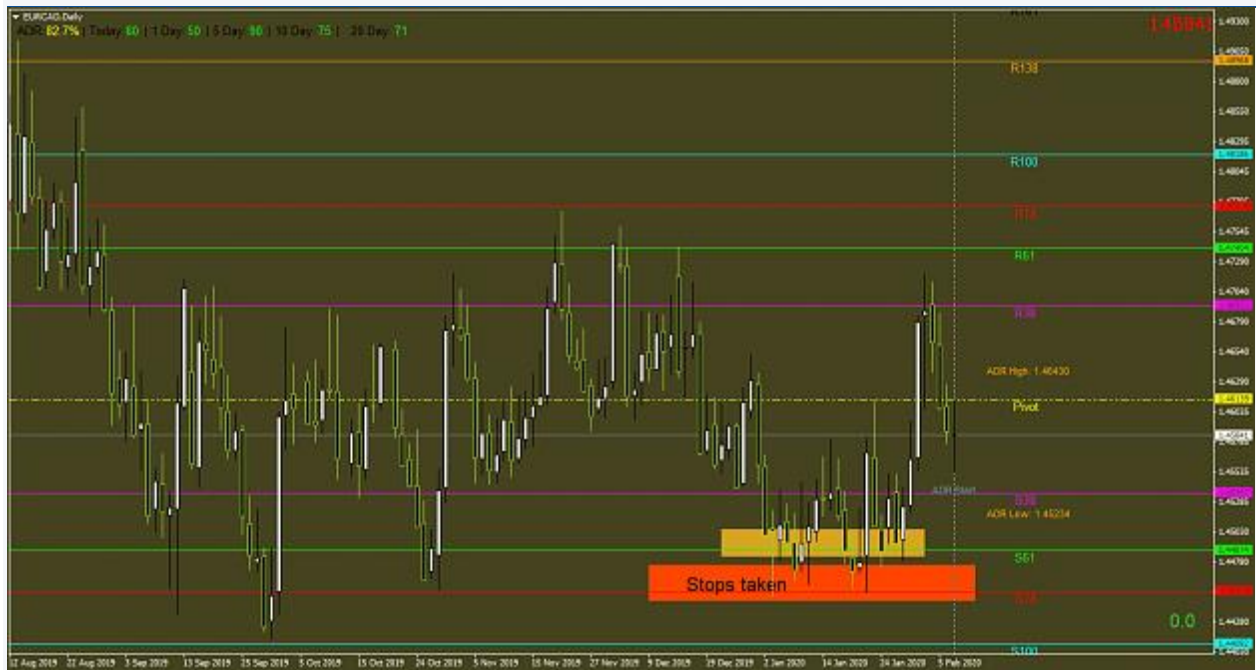
Market makers don't care about your stops or positions what they care about getting their orders filled. In order to do that they must find liquidity clusters so they push price 1st down triggering stops causing their orders filled in millions even billion dollar positions but not all at once. So MM can't place 10 billion order at once so every time price drops 20-30 pips chunk of it gets filled until all orders get filled then break out occurs as real life example below. Range situation is often position building situation therefore why I prefer to trade most likely direction of break out. Example EC break out likely north. Notice multiple spikes down that's MM filling their orders.

Retail traders in general are predictable that is 20-30 pips stops hence on every major support they are below 20-30 pips stops which is

oxymoron why majority lose in this business not understanding how wide stops should be. Another factor positions too big hence small stops to protect account then get killed.

So when price spikes down on major support pivot level **DON'T panic! wait calmly!**

Inductive Reasoning

There are two different methods for reasoning, inductive and deductive. While deductive reasoning looks for certainties, inductive reasoning is used when a circumstance is seen as supplying evidence that a conclusion could be true. The belief in a conclusion based on inductive reasoning is highly probable and based on evidence that can be seen and measured but is not 100% certain. Inductive reasoning is

a tool for making well informed educated guesses using all the available data and information you have at the time. It doesn't mean you will be correct but this type of reasoning will give you the best estimation you can make based on the current known facts. Deductive reasoning is a tool you use when you don't know something to be a fact 100% or you are having to make the best decision in an uncertain environment.

The different types of inductive reasoning:

Generalization: Drawing a general conclusion about all of a group based on an observation. All the chickens I have seen are white, so all chickens must be white.

Statistical: Make a high probability guess based on statistics. If 90% of all chickens are white then out of ten chickens, nine should be white.*

Sample: Making an educated guess about others based on a sample size. If nine out of ten chickens on this farm are white then 90% of chickens will be white on my neighbors farm.

Analogous: Makes a conclusion based on the shared attributes of two types of things. 90% of chickens are white and ducks are birds like chickens so 90% of ducks are probably white too.

Predictive: Makes a conclusion by using a prediction from a past sample of data. When I went to this farm three years ago 90% of the chickens here were white so when I go back tomorrow 90% of the chickens are likely to be white again.

Causal inference: Makes a conclusion using a causal connection. 90% of chickens on this farm are white. I just saw a white bird in the woods behind the farm. The bird I saw was likely a chicken.

Inductive reasoning can be a tool to use for a higher probability of having a correct assumption over randomness. However it can be dangerous when used to see links that are not really there or to assume too much from a limited set of data. In the business, investing, and trading world inductive reasoning must be used a lot of the time because in those environments people must manage so much uncertainty in the future that they can only make the best decisions possible using the available data. **The quality of decisions using inductive reasoning are based on the value and real connections of the data to reality.**

This goes to heart of trading. Calendar events analyses are basically preparing you set of actions depending outcome of data however based on previous examples of market reactions inductive reasoning is used to connect data to reality. Its basically creating an edge over randomness.

Example if you look past green NFP and market was bullish right after on USD then we can use inductive reasoning to predict market reaction on similar economic conditions to be same.

Same manner if market expects rate cut and similarly starts selling it prior of event then we can conclude likely future markets reactions on other rate cuts. In general market is ahead....of actual important events. **Pricing in the event is what usually takes place. Recent example Brexit spike then deflation after the event.**

Sorry for the lack of discourse on Fundamentals as it is beyond my abilities...unfortunately as I am sure I would do much better. But, personally it is too much thinking and guessing on what could happen. As a trained Anesthesiologist, I was never allowed to leave to much to chance inducing, maintaining and reversing the general anesthesia needed for surgery - NOTHING to chance yet prepared for the potential worse !

So, I am too stressed trying to predict outcome of geopolitics, media experts, and especially trying to predict all the big MMs (including most Fx Brokers) and Rebot Servers around the world that take Retailer's money (us) to trade against us !

Note that I did overtrade here no doubt, but the FX Broker places you on a Demo automatically with a \$10,000 play money and a 1:200 leverage. However, despite this, I traded with multiple 0.01 Pip Lots and No or Soft SL levels and trying not affecting the DD that much with the relatively tiny trades versus the total account - actually exactly how the large MMs and Banks do as well.

Note IMHO, that my focus is keeping the "Edge" as noted by MD, Davit and others. The key is keeping your strategy trading the PA with the PVTs so the the PF remains > 2 and DD < 20% overall. The money then follows with P>>L. as long as you watch your Capital i.e. trading only 1-5% of you total account using your "Edge" approach.

I cannot wait to restart a live account again as before. to apply what I have learned here from Davit and Friends !

I wish you all luck as there is so much brilliant information by all participants here.

The Aortic Stenosis condition is found in up to 2% of the aging population - pretty common. It is called the Trans-aortic Valve Replacement (TAVR) done under local anesthesia and sedation to allow opening of your left groin artery to place stents that go up the aortic valve with first ballooning open the valve then slipping a new artificial AV and the stents removed, groin artery stitch up and skin tissues to close up the opening. Then you spend 12 hours laying flat with a 50 lb sand bag in the closed left groin wound and then go home the next morning. Although a critical surgical procedure under flouroscope, the risks of compliments are only 1% complications.

So, if you are symptom-free like I was or am, if greater than 50 years old, have a referral to a cardiologist for an thorough heart PE and stress test echocardiogram that is a test of ultrasound over the skin around your heart if there are any murmurs like I have. Insist on the referral as most GPs are not all good at detailed heart exams on routine physical exams. It may save you life with these modern medical procedures !

I am lucky to have the best cardiologist and cardiothoracic surgeons in Atlanta doing my procedure on March 10, 2020 beginning at 10m EST so I am not really worried... But positive Vibes my Pivior Friends here with be accepted ! Lol !
