



Origin or the source of movement is one of the most important areas to consider when analyzing prices in the RTM style. This area is actually an FTR that forms immediately after a Supply or Demand area. If this FTR can hold the price, it becomes an FL and is commonly referred to as an ORFL, which plays a crucial role in RTM analysis.

The tendency for prices to return to the Origin after an FL is engulfed indicates the significance of this area. ORFLs are actually very important in determining the direction of movement and decision-making location, with many orders loaded within them. Engulfing an ORFL is a very clear sign of a change in the big boys' perspective and is always accompanied by a deep Retrace.
