

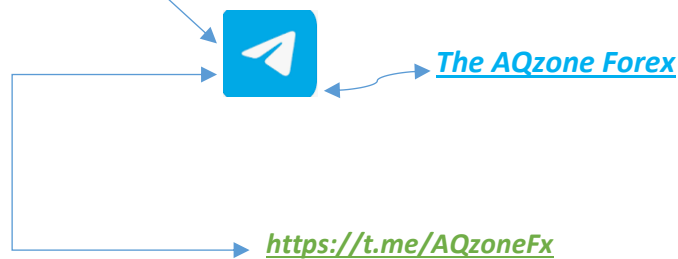


Assalamualaikum warahmatullahi wabarakatuh, this BBMA note is sequence of my other note (SnR & Engulfing) that I have shared with people over the time.

BBMA is very important and useful tool when you use it with [SnR & Engulfing](#) I'm using it since 2019 & I can assure you that if you work hard to understand how to trade BBMA with [SnR & EG](#) then you will be grateful to creator of BBMA.

Use it mostly on HTF to analysis your Bias/Direction or you can say top down analysis.

Time to time I will share how I use it for trading and analysis in my channel/journal please stay connected with me ...



BBMA NOTE:

1. **Extreme:**

- Extreme occurs on only 2 situations like when BB is flat or BB is contracting.
- When BB is expanding that's CSM most of the time.
- Extreme is the 2nd TF confirmation most of the time.
- Extreme B & C cannot use for code RME as those extreme don't have MMT on TF2.
- Extreme A and Advanced Extreme are the most occurring ones. The main Function of the Extreme is to confirm the 2nd TF in a Re-entry and to provide more Confirmation in the 3rd TF.

2. **MHV/MLV:**

- MHV is Extreme on 1 TF below.
- Need to check BB Stoppage (curve BB) to confirm MHV/MLV.
- Reject from top or low BB

3. **CSAK:**

- If it's break MA5/10 MID BB & top/low BB (Strong 1)
- If its break MA5/10, MID BB & MA 50 (powerful 1)
- If its break MA 5/10 MID BB, EMA 50 and top/low BB (powerful 2)
- IF TF1 made CSAK but TF2 make an extreme then it's not valid.
- If TF1 make CSAK and TF2 Make CSM then it's valid.
- Rejection from EMA50 that Invalidates the CSAK Setup

4. **CSM:**

- If BB is vertical situation then the CSM is valid and extreme is invalid.
- If TF1 make CSM then TF2 need to make CSM too and HTF will make reentry for perfect CSM entry.

5. **Signals:** There are 4 types of signal – CSM – CSAK – CSA – ECSAK.

Direction:

- Need to use signals on HTF like MN WK & D1.
- If the MN is in BUY and WK is in sell that's means weekly going for MN Re-Entry.

6. **Re-Entry Setups:** there are 6 types of reentry setup....

- CSM
- CSAK
- CSAK SOP2
 - At the Re-Entry zone the price in TF2 after the formation of Extreme will form CSAK signal. That signal will be used as a setup which we call SOP2.
 - CSAK SOP2 happens always after Re-entry from on HTFs Re-entry. This is very strong Re-entry signal.
- ECSAK
 - While doing the Re-entry of this Setup, the price at TF2 should be at Top/Low BB. Meaning, we should see "Extreme A" or "Extreme B" at TF2 for Code Confirmation.
 - Early CSAK is valid as long as the price doesn't take out MID BB. If after ECSAK formation price doesn't do any Re-Entry and directly hits MID BB then ECSAK is invalid.
- CSA
 - This is the Hardest Setup to Trade. It forms when the Price after Reacting from a Re-entry of the CSM or CSAK Setup, breaks the MA5/10. Then, a retracement will happen back to the MA5/10 for a Re-entry and we can enter based on Confirmation with the help of Codes and Strong Direction Support.
 - Sometime CSA convert into MLV also have to look out of that. It differentiates the price from the 1st type of MLV. If break MA5/10 CSA happens and if price fails to break then it's 1st type of MLV.
- Mid BB

Advance Setup:

Golden Setup:

- It occurs when the additional element (EMA 50) is in a Re-Entry zone.
- Re-entry after CSM/CSAK on same TF.
- In normal setup we Re-entry from MA5/10 high/low but in this case we re-entry from MA5/10 + MA50.
- 1st thing is that EMA 50 must be aligned with Re-Entry zone. 2nd thing one step HTF must be aligned with Re-Entry TF to support it.
- Then we need to apply code as confirmation.
- **SOP2 ENTRY WITH MID BB+MA50+MA5/10**
- EXAMPLE SETUP on H1
 - 1. Re-Entry in the MA5/10 zone that occurs with Mid BB+MA50
 - 2. CSA/CSAK/MMT has been formed on H1
 - 3. MA 5/10 + MID BD + MA 50 overlap / meet into one
 - 4. TF M15 There is a sideways / EXT BB is flat / reject MA50 and TOP BB (wait for CSA or CSAK to come out)
 - 5. TF M5 there is EXT/reject MA50 / TOP BB and forms CSA/CSAK

Nuclear Setup:

- 1st thing we need is Stoppage in that TF where the EMA50 comes out of the BB the stoppage will indicate us the MLV formation of that TF which will support this setup.
- 2nd thing is the break on MID BB in that particular TF, it will create CSAK automatically which will also support nuclear setup.
- When the EMA50 will go outside the BB High/low band while the price will make CSAK and this is the confirmation of nuclear setup.
- For example daily has a nuclear setup in the buy side, meaning the EMA 50 come out from Low-BB, then the EMA 50 will work like magnet & it will attract price toward it but its range would be MID BB to low BB.
- Let's say daily had a Nuclear setup where it supported by MLV (Stoppage) and the break of MID BB forming CSAK sell, during the CSAK sell MA50 went out Low-BB and we can get a Re-entry setup for sell till Low BB and Nuclear setup created Re-entry on HTF.

Diamond Setup:

- This setup is a setup to confirm the re-entry that applies in large timeframes (ZLL setup on H4). Setup Confirm. Full Margin. Entry in H1.
- When the candle rejects EMA50 (which is out of BB) and at the same time makes EXT.
- The entry would be in the second candle, preferably in the region where the first rejection occurred. When the market is very volatile, this second candle does not even appear! Candle closing after EMA50 makes setup invalid -> CUTLOSS!

BMW Setup:

- It only consists of a Single TF (only on H4). It also includes EMA50 as a supporter.
- When the EMA50 comes out of the Top or Low BB, we have to wait until it gets back to the BB again. When it gets back into the Bollinger Bands, we have to see what Structure the Price has created or what the Price is doing on daily (we need Re-Entry on daily TF)
- The confirmation is H4 TF direction should be same as daily TF.
- Very often Golden setup occurs after the BMW setup and also On H4 you will find EXT/MLV as confirmation of BMW setup.

ZLL Setup:

- ZLL start when all the MAs cross MID BB in a certain direction.
- It ends when there is a formation of **nuclear setup** in the same TF.
- Example, SOP 1. When MA50 cross Mid BB for the first time wait for Re-entry (CSM).
- 2nd TF will create Extreme / Reject from TOP/LOW BB/ Diamond setup or BMW.
- On 3rd TF we will find Extreme/MHV/EG-EF also sometime 3rd TF can make DT/DB.

CODE: REE-REM-RME RRE, CODE IS THE CONFIRMATION OF RE-ENTRY SETUP.

REE:

- In Monthly TF, we have a Re-entry. So, on TF1, we have "R".
- In Weekly TF, we have Extreme formed. So, on TF2, it will be "E".
- In Daily TF, after the formation of Extreme ,the Price does not come back to form MLV and it Directly forms CSAK and confirms the Code "REE"

REM:

- In Daily TF, we have a Re-entry "R".
- In H4 TF, we have Extreme "E".
- While in H1 TF, we will get MLV "M".
- So, the code REM will be applied on these three TFs (D, H4, and H1).After the CSAK on TF3, "REM" will be confirmed.

RME:

- On Weekly TF (TF1), we have Re-entry "R".
- On Daily TF (TF2), we will get Extreme + MLV Point. So, as a whole, we will consider it MLV on second TF and be "M".
- On H4 TF (TF3), we will get "Extreme A" on both Marked Points of TF2 (Extreme + MLV).
- Then after CSAK on TF3, we will trade this Code. -Normally for other Codes, TF3 used to confirm the Code by forming CSAK. But in this Code, TF2 confirms "RME" after the CSAK on TF2.

RRE:

- The 1st TF as usual will be at a Re-Entry zone of MA5/10.
- The 2nd TF will be also at Re-Entry area of MA50/10 or MID BB
- The 3rd TF will provide an extreme and a CSAK signal confirming code RRE on a certain RE-ENTRY.
