
March 2022 compared with February 2022

Industrial production down by 1.8% in the euro area and by 1.2% in the EU

Down by 0.8% and up by 0.7% compared with March 2021

In March 2022, the seasonally adjusted industrial production fell by 1.8% in the **euro area** and by 1.2% in the **EU**, compared with February 2022, according to estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In February 2022, industrial production increased by 0.5% in the **euro area** and by 0.6% in the **EU**.

In March 2022 compared with March 2021, industrial production decreased by 0.8% in the **euro area** and increased by 0.7% in the **EU**.



Monthly comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

In the **euro area** in March 2022, compared with February 2022, production of capital goods fell by 2.7%, non-durable consumer goods by 2.3%, intermediate goods by 2.0% and energy by 1.7%, while production of durable consumer goods rose by 0.8%.

In the **EU**, production of capital goods fell by 2.6%, intermediate goods by 1.4%, non-durable consumer goods by 1.0%, while production of durable consumer goods rose by 0.7% and energy by 1.3%.


Among Member States for which data are available, the largest monthly decreases were registered in **Slovakia** (-5.3%), **Germany** (-5.0%) and **Luxembourg** (-3.9%). The highest increases were observed in **Lithuania** (+11.3%), **Estonia** (+5.1%), **Bulgaria** and **Greece** (both +5.0%).

Annual comparison by main industrial grouping and by Member State

In the **euro area** in March 2022, compared with March 2021, production of energy fell by 4.0%, capital goods by 2.7%, intermediate goods by 0.1%, while production of non-durable consumer goods rose by 2.8% and durable consumer goods by 6.6%.

In the **EU**, production of durable consumer goods rose by 6.6%, non-durable consumer goods by 4.9%, energy by 2.7% and intermediate goods by 0.9%, while production of capital goods fell by 2.5%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the largest annual decreases were registered in **Slovakia** (-7.3%), **Ireland** (-5.5%) and **Germany** (-4.1%). The highest increases were observed in **Lithuania** (+25.9%), **Bulgaria** (+19.1%) and **Poland** (+17.4%).



Geographical information

The **euro area** (EA19) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU27) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechia, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland and Sweden.

Cyprus has a derogation with respect to Regulation (EU) 2019/2152 to have a longer deadline until the end of 2023.

Methods and definitions

The **index of industrial production** measures the evolution of the volume of production for industry excluding construction, based on data adjusted for calendar and seasonal effects.

Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data.

Total industry covers NACE rev.2 sections B to D. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

Revisions and timetable

Compared with data issued in the News Release 43/2022 of 20 April 2022, the monthly percentage change for February 2022 has been revised from +0.7% to +0.5% in the euro area and remained unchanged at +0.6% in the EU. The annual percentage change has been revised from +2.0% to +1.7% in the euro area and from +3.0% to +2.8% in the EU.
